**Services at or within one mile from trailheads**

## **Springfield Trailhead – Mile Marker 0**

**Parking:** Yes

**Restroom:** No

**Water:** No

**Food/Restaurant:** Café at Courtyard Marriott, ¼-mile east on Kearney

**Lodging:** Courtyard Marriott, ¼-mile east on Kearney (417) 869-6700

**Other:** On city bus route, 2 miles east of Springfield-Branson Regional Airport, Downtown Springfield is approximately 5 miles southeast of trailhead with many services and is connected via the signed on-street bike route system which is developing (Take Kearney Street east to Fullbright and follow the bike signs)

## **Willard Trailhead – Mile Marker 6**

**Parking:** Yes

**Restroom:** Yes, across the street at Willard City Pool (Open: 9AM -10PM spring to fall, weather dependent in winter), Gas station about ¼-mile south of trailhead

**Water:** Yes, across the street at Willard City Pool (Open: 9AM -10PM spring to fall, weather dependent in winter), Gas station about ¼-mile south of trailhead

**Food/Restaurant:** Downtown BBQ across from the trailhead, Junction Cafe and the junction of 160 & 123, Pippin's Restaurant, Subway, Pizza Hut, Sonic

**Lodging:** No

**Other:** Gas station convenience store at Highway 160 / 123 junction (Mile Marker 8)

## **Walnut Grove Trailhead – Mile Marker 16**

**Parking:** Yes

**Restroom:** May's Mart gas station & convenience on old main street, 1 mile west on BB, turn south at light

**Water:** May's Mart gas station & convenience on old main street, 1 mile west on BB, turn south at light

**Food/Restaurant:** The Dinner Bell on old main street, 1 mile west on BB, across from gas station

**Lodging:** By mile marker 20—Ridgerunners Rest Stop Bunkhouse & Breakfast, camping too (417) 694-2464

**Other:** Equestrian parking, The Cat's Meow antique shop is 1 mile west on BB across from gas station

## **Wishart Trailhead – Mile Marker 24**

**Parking:** Yes

**Restroom:** No

**Water:** No, but there is a pop machine across the street

**Food/Restaurant:** No

**Lodging:** No

**Other:** Gray's Roadside Attraction across the street with hillbilly-mobile and carnival artifacts, the Highline Bridge is the longest bridge on the trail just a mile north of Wishart at 317 feet long

## **Bolivar Trailhead – Mile Marker 35+ (extra mileage due to road detour)**

**Parking:** Yes

**Restroom:** Yes (Open: 8AM-3PM)

**Water:** Yes

**Food/Restaurant:** Several eateries including: Kathy's Pasta on Main Street southeast of the trailhead, El Rodeo Mexican Restaurant 1 mile east of the trailhead on the east side of the downtown square

**Lodging:** Country Inn (417) 326-8004, Bolivar Super 8 (417) 777-8888

**Other:** Covered pavilion
